The Scriptures say, 'Moses gave them bread from heaven to eat.'" ³² Jesus said, "I tell you the truth, Moses didn't give you bread from heaven. My Father did. And now He offers you the true bread from heaven. ³³ The true bread of God is the One who comes down from heaven and gives life to the world." ³⁴ "Sir," they said, "give us that bread every day." ³⁵ Jesus replied, "I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never be hungry again. Whoever believes in me will never be thirsty. ³⁶ But you haven't believed in me even though you have seen me..." ⁴⁵ As it is written in the Scriptures, 'They will all be taught by God.' Everyone who listens to the Father and learns from Him comes to Me. ⁴⁶ (Not that anyone has ever seen the Father; only I, who was sent from God, have seen Him.) ⁴⁷ "I tell you the truth, anyone who believes has eternal life. ⁴⁸ Yes, I am the bread of life!"
