Three Purposes Of Doors:

1. I Am _____ In Christ, He Is My _____.

But he who enters by the door is a shepherd of the sheep. ³To him the doorkeeper opens, and the sheep hear his voice, and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. ⁴When he puts forth all his own, he goes ahead of them, and the sheep follow him because they know his voice.

A. God _____ For Me.

And I will cause you to pass under the rod [as the shepherd does his sheep when he counts them, and I will count you as Mine and I will constrain you] and bring you into the covenant to which you are permanently bound.

B. God _____ Me.

But God's truth stands firm like a foundation stone with this inscription: "The LORD knows those who are His," and "All who belong to the LORD must turn away from evil."

C. God _____ Me.

When he puts forth all his own, he goes ahead of them, and the sheep follow him because they know his voice.
