And when He had spoken this, He ^{}said to him, **“Follow Me!”** ²⁰ Peter, turning around, ^{*}saw the disciple whom Jesus loved following them; the one who also had leaned back on His bosom at the supper and said, “Lord, who is the one who betrays You?” ²¹ So Peter seeing him ^{*}said to Jesus, “Lord, and what about this man?” ²² Jesus ^{*}said to him, **“If I want him to remain until I come, what is that to you? You follow Me!”***
