Now when Jesus came into the district of Caesarea Philippi, He was asking His disciples, "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?"<sup>14</sup> And they said, "Some say John the Baptist; and others, Elijah; but still others, Jeremiah, or one of the prophets."<sup>15</sup> He \*said to them, "But <u>who</u> do you say that I am?"<sup>16</sup> Simon Peter answered, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Matthew 16:13-15 (NASB)




