12 Steps of C

Step 1: We admitted we were powerless over our addictions and compulsive behaviors, that our lives had become unmanageable. Step 2: We came to believe that a power greater than ourselves could restore us to sanity. Step 3: We made a decision to turn our wills and our lives over to the care of God. **Step 4**: We made a searching and fearless moral inventory of ourselves. Step 5: We admitted to God, to ourselves. and to another human being the exact nature of our wrongs. Step 6: We were entirely ready to have God remove all these defects of character. Step 7: We humbly asked Him to remove all our shortcomings. Step 8: We made a list of all persons we had harmed and became willing to make amends to them all. Step 9: We made direct amends to such people whenever possible, except when to do so would injure them or others. Step 10: We continued to take personal inventory, and when we were wrong, promptly admitted it. Step 11: We sought through prayer and meditation to improve our conscious contact with God, praying only for knowledge of His will for us and the power to carry it out. Step 12: Having had a spiritual experience as a result of these steps, we tried to carry this message to others and to practice these principles in all our affairs.

That if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; 10 for with the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation.¹¹ For the Scripture says, **"WHOEVER** BELIEVES IN HIM WILL NOT BE DISAPPOINTED." ¹²For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the same Lord is Lord of all, abounding in riches for all who call on Him; ¹³ for "WHOEVER WILL CALL ON THE NAME OF THE LORD WILL BE SAVED." 14 How then will they call on Him in whom they have not believed? How will they believe in Him whom they have not heard? And how will they hear without a preacher? ¹⁵ How will they preach unless they are sent? Just as it is written, "HOW BEAUTIFUL ARE THE FEET OF THOSE WHO BRING GOOD NEWS OF GOOD THINGS!" ¹⁶However, they did not all heed the good news; for Isaiah says, "LORD, WHO HAS BELIEVED OUR REPORT?" ¹⁷So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.
