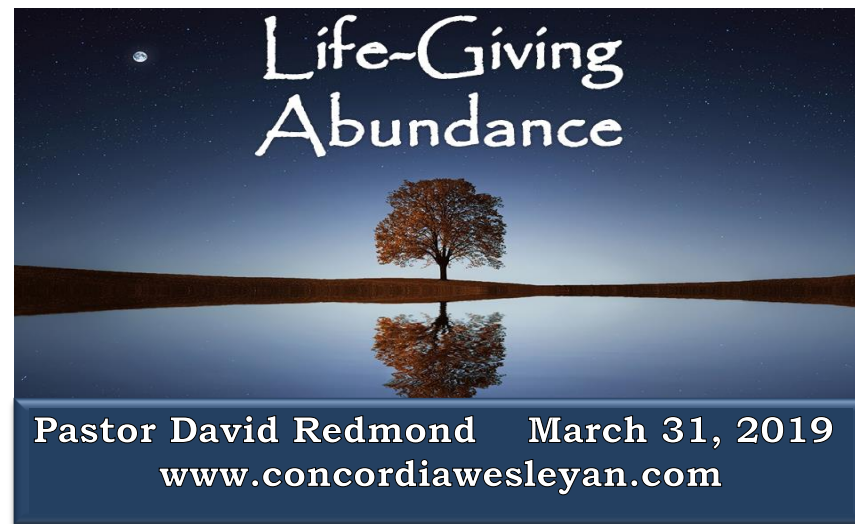
God’s greatest gift is _____.
