

Enthusiasm =

a feeling of energetic interest in a particular subject or activity and an eagerness to be involved in it to be involved in it, or a subject that invokes or produces such a feeling; something inspiring zeal or fervor.

Enthusiasm entered the English language around the beginning of the 17th century. It was borrowed from the Greek *enthousiasmos*, meaning "inspiration or possession by a god." (merriam-webster.com)


