<b><u>Justification</u></b> Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Romans 5:1  Since we have now been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath through him! <sup>10</sup> For if, while we were God's enemies, we were reconciled to him through the death of his Son, how much more, having been reconciled, shall we be saved through his life! Redeemed Adopted.....Sanctified Accepted.....Justified Saved.....Cleansed Called.....Chosen	<b><u>Sanctification</u></b> Do not let sin control the way you live; do not give in to sinful desires. <sup>13</sup> Do not let any part of your body become an instrument of evil to serve sin. Instead, give yourselves completely to God, for you were dead, but now you have new life. So use your whole body as an instrument to do what is right for the glory of God. <sup>14</sup> For sin shall no longer be your master, because you are not under the law, but under grace. Romans 6:12-14  ...Work hard to show the results of your salvation, obeying God with deep reverence and fear. <sup>13</sup> For God is working in you, giving you the desire and the power to do what pleases him. Philippians 2: 13-14	<b><u>Glorification</u></b> What I am saying, dear brothers and sisters, is that our physical bodies cannot inherit the Kingdom of God. These dying bodies cannot inherit what will last forever. <sup>51</sup> But let me reveal to you a wonderful secret. We will not all die, but we will all be transformed! <sup>52</sup> It will happen in a moment, in the blink of an eye, when the last trumpet sounds, those who have died will be raised to live forever. And we who are living will also be transformed. <sup>53</sup> For our dying bodies must be transformed into bodies that will never die, our mortal bodies must be transformed into immortal bodies. ### **My Response – Receive God's gift**

**A**dmit that I am a sinner and need God's forgiveness.

*As the Scriptures say, "No one is righteous—not even one." Romans 3:10*

**B**elieve that Jesus died on the cross for my sin and rose again.

*But to all who believed him and accepted him,*

*he gave the right to become children of God. John 1:12*

**C**onfess my sin and confess Jesus Christ as my Lord and Savior, and rest in His finished work.

*If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup>For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by openly declaring your faith that you are saved. Romans 10:9-10 (see also I John 1:5-9)*

**D**etermine to obey and honor God in my daily life.

*If any of you wants to be my follower, you must turn from your selfish ways, take up your cross daily, and follow me. Luke 9:23 (NLT)*

She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins. Matthew 1:21 (NIV)

For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.

**Save** (sozo) = to save, to keep safe and sound, to heal, to rescue from danger or destruction; to save a suffering one from perishing; to preserve one who is in danger of destruction; to deliver from the penalties of judgment. To make one whole and complete in spirit, soul, and body.

The one who believes in the Son of God has the testimony in himself; the one who does not believe God has made Him a liar, because he has not believed in the testimony that God has given concerning His Son. <sup>11</sup>And the testimony is this, that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. <sup>12</sup>He who has the Son has the life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have the life. <sup>13</sup>These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know that you have eternal life. ## **To be saved by God is to experience the \_\_\_\_\_ life.**

For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ.  
II Corinthians 5:21 (NLT)

He died for everyone so that those who receive his new life will no longer live for themselves. Instead, they will live for Christ, who died and was raised for them.  
II Corinthians 5:15 (NLT)

My old self has been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me. So I live in this earthly body by trusting in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me. Galatians 2:20 (NLT)

Those who belong to Christ Jesus have nailed the passions and desires of their sinful nature to his cross and crucified them there. <sup>25</sup>Since we are living by the Spirit, let us follow the Spirit's leading in every part of our lives. Galatians 5:24-25 (NLT)

Then Jesus said to his disciples, "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me. <sup>25</sup>For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me will find it."  
Matthew 16:24-25 (NIV)
